- NO REPORTING-PRIVATE
- Metals daily markets does not determine value
- Coins are Portable
- Easily Divisible
- Limited quantities minted

BULLION

1000 Pa

- Some cases a 1099 Required
- Daily Markets determine current values
- Bars not so easily
- Harder to divide units
- Year to Year usually mints increase mintages

Private Transactions:

• Sales are not required to be reported to any government agency.

• Transferable:

- 3-5 years to Appreciate:
 - We suggest you hold your coins for 3-5 years to give them a chance to appreciate
- When you want to liquidate <u>DO NOT</u> take them to a coin dealer:
 - Dealers want to buy inventory for the lowest price possible to be able to resale for profit
 - When you are ready to liquidate your portfolio, the best way is through an auction
 You have the dealer there, the investor there, the collectors there
 You'll realize your greatest profits at an auction


S&P 500 index (58%).

- 1. Always buy well known collectibles.
- 2. Quality Always buy the highest quality you can afford.
 - Coins are graded on a scale of 1 70 (lowest highest grade)
- 3. Changeovers when something different happens with a coin.
 - Last year of a design
 - First year of a design
